Before the start of your shift, please check-in at **Volunteer Registration**, which is located near the Railroad Stage shuttle drop-off.

Volunteer Registration will direct you to the trailer (near the golf cart corral) where you will check-in with Jeff.

Here's what you can expect:

Moving vans full of performers and band equipment would be a daunting task without Safety Escort volunteers. As these vehicles make their way to the stages, you and a team of fellow escorts will walk the vans through the crowd and make sure Festival-goers are clear of the vehicle's path.

Also, when trains come through the Festival site, your team of Safety Escorts, along with Operations personnel and police, will ensure that nobody tries to cross the tracks.

Safety escorts are important volunteers whose presence: 1- guarantees a safe Festival experience for everyone, 2- enables performers get to their venue safely and on time.

Tips:

- * You are welcome to bring your own chair
- * Wear comfortable shoes and bring sunscreen
- * Please wait for your replacement before leaving your post at the end of your shift.
