

Thank you for volunteering as a **On-Call Volunteer**

At the start of your shift, please check-in at **Volunteer Registration**, which is located near the Railroad Stage shuttle drop-off.

As an on-call volunteer, you agree to be on-site and on-call during a specific period of time.

You will need to have a cell phone with you.

Here's what you can expect:

As an on-call volunteer, you'll be on call for whatever volunteer needs arise. Someone cancelled their shift in vending? You get to sell t-shirts and hats today. A few extra Donation Station Greeters are needed? Welcome visitors and collect donations for an hour or two.

When you arrive at Volunteer Registration, they will let you know if there are any immediate volunteer needs. If there are, they will give you information about your assignment and tell you where and who to check in with. If there aren't any needs at the time you check-in, they will put your name and cell phone number on a list, along with the time you are available. If a need arises during your scheduled time, they will call you and give you the details.

- * Length of your shift will vary from assignment to assignment.
- * Wear sunscreen and comfortable shoes!
- * If there is an assignment that you are not comfortable doing, please let the folks at Volunteer Registration know – we want you to enjoy your volunteer experience!
